## Safety Rules

Fellow Hogzillians, we are about to embark on our great adventure. As with any adventure, there will be thrills and challenges. There will also be hazards to be managed. While we are focusing on the art we are about to create, we cannot lose sight of our responsibilities to protect our wellbeing and the wellbeing of the surroundings we've been allowed to use. 1. **WEB SITE:** Our web site is at <http://hdvproductionservices.com/hogzilla>
2. **TRANSPORTATION:** All personal vehicles will be parked at the equestrian center parking lot. See the directions on our web site. A bus will be provided to take you to the shoot. The bus driver will have a sign-in/sign-out sheet. You must print your name, a description of your car, and your time in and out. This is to help us to know that no one has been left behind at the end of the day.
3. **GUESTS:** Please do not bring any guests with you unless you have first cleared the guest with the Producer, the Director, or the 1<sup>st</sup> AD. This includes parents, significant others, and BFFs.
4. **HOUSEKEEPING:** Jim Brandon is a nearly pristine wilderness area that has very generously been provided for our use. We have a responsibility to leave it in the same condition in which we found it. Please do not throw anything on the ground. Trash receptacles will be provided. If you don't see one right away, please put the candy wrapper in your pocket until you do. Please don't litter.
5. **SMOKING:** This has been a very dry season. The park is covered with dry pine straw, leaves, and other combustibles. Please smoke only in designated areas (where there are butt cans) and be sure your smokes are out when you leave them. **DON'T PUT YOUR SMOKES OUT ON THE GROUND.** Smokey Bear isn't here, so only you can prevent forest fires.
6. **BUDDY SYSTEM:** It's dark in the woods at night (duh). This is really important...don't wander off alone. Take a buddy with you. Please let someone know when you've left and when you return. Remember, Andy hasn't shot Hogzilla yet.
7. **RVs:** No smoking. Please clean up after yourself. Please use toilet paper sparingly and please do not put any feminine products in the toilets – they'll clog.
