## Safety Rules

Fellow Shiners, we are about to embark on our great adventure. As with any adventure, there will be thrills and challenges. There will also be hazards to be managed. While we are focusing on the art we are about to create, we cannot lose sight of our responsibilities to protect our wellbeing and the wellbeing of the surroundings we've been allowed to use. So, please take the time to read these few guidelines.

1. **WEB SITE:** Our web site is at <http://hdvproductionservices.com/shiningwater/>.
2. **TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation is limited, so please be on time. If you have a ride to catch, and you're late, the whole production stops for you (how embarrassing).
3. **GUESTS:** Please do not bring any guests with you unless you have first cleared the guest with the Producer, the Director, or the 1st AD. This includes parents, significant others, and BFFs (yes, that even includes Paris Hilton).
4. **HOUSEKEEPING:** We are guests on board the boats and at the facilities we will be using. We have a responsibility to leave them in the same condition in which we found them. Please do not throw anything on the ground, on the deck or in the water. Trash receptacles will be provided. If you don't see one right away, please put the candy wrapper in your pocket until you do. Please don't litter. Your mother isn't here to clean up after you.
5. **SMOKING:** Please smoke only in designated areas (where there are butt cans or ash trays) and be sure your smokes are out when you leave them. **DON'T PUT YOUR SMOKES OUT ON THE GROUND OR IN THE OCEAN. DON'T SMOKE ON THE BOAT WITHOUT THE CAPTAIN'S PERMISSION.**
